

Knitting

<u>Gauge</u>	<u>Yards</u>	
3-3 $\frac{1}{2}$ sts/"	800 yds	} 36-38
4-4 $\frac{1}{2}$ sts/"	900 yds	
5- sts/"	1200 yds	
5 $\frac{1}{2}$ sts/"	1500 yds	

Cardigan = Add one skein
Pattern = Add one skein

CABLE

Row 1: (Right Side) P2, K6, P2
Row 2: (Wrong Side) K2, P6, K2
Row 3: Row 1
Row 4: Row 2
Row 5: P2, S1 3 sts to cable needle and hold to front of work,
K3, K3 sts from cable needle, P2
Row 6: Row 2
Repeat

MAKE BOBBLE

MB - 1 stitch

Row 1: KF, KB, KF of next st.
Row 2: Turn and P3
Row 3: Turn and K3
Row 4: Turn and P3
Row 5: Turn and S1, K2 together, PSSO

FEATHER AND FAN

multiple of 18 sts

Row 1: (RS) K
Row 2: P
Row 3: *(K2 tog) 3x, (yo, K1) 6x, (K2 tog) 3x repeat from *
Row 4: K
Repeat row 1-4

EYELIT SCARF

CO 21 sts

#13 needle

make stripes of 8 rows garter st, 4 rows fancy st.

Fancy stitch: Row 1: *YO, K2 tog* always repeat this row

MOCK CABLE

3 sts

Row 1: sl 1, K2, yo, pssso the 2K sts

Row 2: Purl

Repeat

GRANITE RELIEF STITCH

Multiple of 2 + 2

Worked over 4 rows

Row 1: K

Row 2: *K2 tog*

Row 3: in each st, K 2 sts (once in front, once in back)

Row 4: P

TUBE KNIT

Pick up even # of stitches

Even # of rows

K1, YF, SSPW, YB

Same row over and over

EYELETS

Multiple of 3 + 2

Work 2 rows in st st, starting K.

Row 3: (RS) K2, *YF, K2 tog, K1, repeat from * to end

Row 4: P

Repeat these 4 rows

ARROWHEAD LACE

Multiple of 10 + 1

Row 1: (RS) K1, *(YF, sl 1, K1, pssso) twice, K1, (K2 tog, YF) twice
K1; repeat from * to end

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: K2 *YF, sl 1, K1, pssso, YF, sl1, K2tog, pssso, YF, K2 tog,
YF, K3, repeat from * to last 9 stitches, YF, sl1, K1, pssso,
YF, sl1, K2 tog, pssso, YF, K2 tog, YF, K2

Row 4: Purl
repeat 4 rows

BRAMBLE STITCH

Multiple 4 + 2

Row 1: (R side) Purl

Row 2: K1, *(K1, P1, K1) into next st, P3 tog; Repeat from * to last st, K1

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: K1, *P3 tog, (K1, P1, K1) into next st; repeat * to last st, K1.

Repeat 4 rows

RIBBON STITCH

Row 1: (WS) and all other WS rows P

Rows 2, 4, 6, 10, and 12 - K

Row 8: KF, KB of each st (thus doubling the # of sts)

Row 14: K2 tog across row (orig. # of sts restored)

Repeat rows 1 - 14

SIMPLE LACE RIB

Multiple of 6 + 1

Row 1: (RS): (KB1) twice, * K3, (KB1) 3x; repeat from * to last 5 sts, K3, (KB1) twice.

Row 2: (PB1) twice, * P3 (PB1) 3x; repeat from * to last 5 sts, P3, (PB1) twice.

Row 3: (KB1) twice, * YF sl 1, K2 tog, pssso, YF, (KB1) 3x; repeat from * to last 5 sts, YF sl 1, K2 tog, pssso, YF, (KB1) twice.

Row 4: as row 2

Repeat these 4 rows

DIAMOND PANEL

Worked over 11 sts on a background of st st

Row 1: (RS) P2, K2 tog, (K1, YF) twice, K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, P2

Row 2: and every alt row: K2, P7, K2

Row 3: P2, K2 tog, YF, K3, YF, sl 1, K1, pssso, P2

Row 5: P2, K1, YF, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, K2 tog, YF, K1, P2

Row 7: P2, K2, YF, sl 1, K2 tog, pssso, YF, K2, P2

Row 8: same as row 2

Repeat these 8 rows

YO BUTTONHOLE

Result is round
BH - 1 st buttonhole
Work up to place for buttonhole
YO, K2 tog
Overcast Edges to finish

HORIZONTAL BUTTONHOLE

#1

8 sts - edge
Row 1: K
Row 2: P
Row 3: K
Row 4: P
Row 5: K2, B0 4sts, K2
Row 6: P2, C0 4sts, P2
Row 7: K
Row 8: P

1 ROW BUTTONHOLES

RS

S1 1st, YF
S1 1 st, B.O. 1st
S1 1st, B.O. 1st
S1 1st, B.O. 1st
S1 first st on RHN to LHN - Turn

WS

YF Make top of buttonhole as follows:
P into first st on LHN, and S1 the new P st back from RHN to LHN,
Repeat 3 times until 4 sts - 1 more than at B.O. Turn

RS

S1 first st from LHN to RHN and B.O. 1st (extra st)
S1 1 st on RHN to LHN and knit across row.

VERTICAL BUTTONHOLE

6 sts

Row 1: K

Row 2: P

Row 3: K3, join another yarn and K3

Row 4: P3, using other yarn, P3

Row 5: K3 with 1st yarn, K3 with 2nd yarn

Row 6: P6 across with one yarn

Row 7: K6

Row 8: P6

FUR STITCH

Worked even # of sts + 1

Odd rows are wrong side

Row 1: K

Row 2: K1, *K1 without dropping it from L needle; bring YF, wind it around your L thumb in order to form a loop, bring yarn to back; K the st of L needle once more and let it drop from LHN; YO, pass 2 sts of RHN over the YO, K1

Row 3: K

Row 4: Row 2

KITCHENER STITCH

sts must be evenly divided on 2 needles, wrong sides together
Thread tail through wool needle - Name needles "Front needle (FN)
and back needle (BN)

*Pull wool through first st on FN as if to K
Take st off
Pull wool through second st on FN as if to P
Leave st on
Pull wool through first st on BN as if to P
Take st off
Pull wool through second st on BN as if to K
Leave st on
Repeat from *

VANDYKE FAGGOT

Multiple 3 sts
Row 1: (RS) *K1, (YO) twice, K2tog; repeat from *
Row 2: Purl, purling each first YO once and dropping each second YO
off needle
Row 3: *K2tog, (YO) twice, K1; repeat from *
Row 4: Repeat Row 2

FEATHERED LACE LADDER

Multiple of 4 sts
Row 1: (RS)
*K2tog, YO twice, SSK; repeat from *
Row 2: *P1, (P1, K1) into double YO, P1; repeat from *

TRELLIS LACE

Multiple of 6 + 5
Row 1: (RS) K4, *YF, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, YF, K3; repeat from *
to last st, K1
Row 2: P
Row 3: K1, *YF, sl1, K2tog, pssso, YF, K3; repeat from * to last
4 sts, YF, sl1, K2tog, pssso, YF, K1
Row 4: P
Repeat these 4 rows

CONDOMINIUM SWEATER

Pattern - even # sts

Row 1: K

Row 2: K

Row 3: K1, YO, repeat across row

Row 4: K1, drop YO st, repeat across row

Repeat Rows 1 - 4
