

SWEATER OF THE MONTH

OPAL

Materials: 6 ske. Opal by Busse (600 m.)
#5 and #10 Knitting Needles. H Crochet Hook.

Gauge: 3 sts./"

Stitches: Stockinette Stitch (Row 1: K, Row 2: P. and repeat)
Garter stitch (Knit every row)

Note: Entire sweater is worked with a double strand of yarn and horizontal.

Back: C.O. 54 sts. and work in st. st. Work Garter st stripes as desired. Continue for 18" or desired width for sweater. B.O.

Front: Work same as back.

Finishing: 1. Sew shoulder seams. Sew one side seam to underarm.
2. With H crochet hook, right side facing you and bottom of sweater, pick up one st. in each st. and place on #5 Knitting Needle.
3. Next row- work in rib K1, P1. Every 5th st. work 2 sts tog. (This reduces the st. count and makes a nice tight rib.)
4. Work even in ribbing for 2½" and B.O.
5. Sew other underarm seam.
6. With H Crochet Hook work 1 row SC around neck and armhole edges.
